Chamonix Adventure Festival, in partnership with the town of Chamonix Mont-Blanc, has announced this year's festival programme with outdoor screenings and filmmaker events complementing the festival film selection.

A **film programme** packed with inspiring tales will be screened over 4 nights, with filmmakers, explorers and athletes on hand to share their exploits and inspirations. From steep skiing in Alaska, to surfing in the North Sea, remote kayaking in Patagonia, to catapult base jumping across the fjords of Norway! The festival kicks off with an **open air screening** in the Place Triangle de l'Amitié in Chamonix from 8pm on **25th March**. Spectators will be entertained with a visual feast of some of the most spectacular films in this year's selection, with some breathtaking surprises in store - including the world premier of the latest adventures of the Flying Frenchies - **Back to the Fjords**.

The remainder of the incredibly varied festival film selection will be screened at the Cinema Vox, with appearances from adventurers and filmmakers, across 3 nights of screenings on 26th, 27th and 28th March.

On Thursday don't miss the inspiring adventures of Nat&Co and their team ski ascents of various peaks. Come running along the coast of Africa or cycle from China to France in **Sous les Ailes de l'Hippocampe**. Or perhaps attempting unclimbed peaks in the Himalayas is more your bag?

The award winning and thought provoking film **DamNation** (presented by Patagonia) will be shown late afternoon, to allow screening of the full film - together with a couple of short adventures.

Chamonix based filmmaker Bjarne Sahlen's latest ski film, **Dream Line**, will screen on Friday, and we'll go kayaking around Patagonia fjords and skiing couloirs on Baffin Island to boot amongst other adventures.

For the last night of films, get ready to go on a biking adventure in Argentina, and take an original look at surfing and paragliding in two beautifully shot short films. The festival grand finale will be the highly acclaimed and multi award winning story of climbing in Yosemite, **Valley Uprising**, by Sender Films.

All films in the festival selection will be judged by our international jury for the chance to be presented one of the festival awards on the last night of film screenings. The festival awards will be presented this year by key festival partners, with industry partners G technology, PNY and Sony joining the festival family this year.
